MCCH's Meal Program serves over 100,000 meals per year to the men at our shelter!

We rely on our community to donate prepared meals for breakfast, lunch, and dinner because we do not have the capacity to cook food on-site. Our meal donors allow us to help the men move into housing as quickly as possible.

1. Schedule

Meal donations for the men's emergency shelter must be scheduled online at www.tinyurl.com/mcchmeals

2. Drop Off BEFORE the following (even the day before!)

Breakfast: 7:30am

Lunch: 11:30am

Dinner: 5:00pm

Please prepare meals for 200 people.

Where should meals be delivered?

11600 Nebel Street, Rockville, MD 20852

Pull around back and our team will help you unload.

What kind of meals are appropriate?

We appreciate your efforts to prepare healthy meals for our clients.

Can we cook meals on-site?

No, we don't have a kitchen on-site to prepare food. We do have warming ovens and serving tables to reheat food and keep it warm.

What should I do if I need to cancel?

Can I still help if I am unable to prepare an entire meal?

Yes! Donations of milk, orange juice, cereal, granola bars, bottled water, coffee, tea, creamer, and sugar, as well as paper/plastic plates, bowls, cups, and utensils are helpful. These food items are also welcomed: frozen lasagna, frozen vegetables and rotisserie chickens.
